Here is some guidance for staff, and later House rules for public. This is not an exhaustive list but may help with current operations;

Staff Training

Basic Covid-19 Reminder (Current Guidance / Symptoms to recognise) *

Advise staff displaying current symptoms, or self-isolating /self-quarantine to stay at home.

Get a test if displaying symptoms,*

Make staff aware of Risk Assessment,

Make staff familiar with new control measures, procedures,

Avoid physical contact, Social distancing,

Wash your hands thoroughly Regularly, minimum of 20 secs,

Avoid touching your face, or, unnecessary contact.

***Symptoms**

The most common symptoms are new:

- continuous cough
- fever/high temperature (37.8C or greater)
- loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste (anosmia)

A new continuous cough is where you:

- have a new cough that's lasted for an hour
- have had 3 or more episodes of coughing in 24 hours
- are coughing more than usual

Current Scot Govt Guidance FACTS

- **Face** covering on public transport and enclosed public spaces
- **Avoid** crowded places
- **Clean** your hands regularly and as soon as you get home
- **Two** metres (6 feet) away from other people
- **Self-isolate** if you have symptoms and book a test

Bars Things to do:

Deep clean

Reduce Staff Numbers, (Alternate Shift Patterns , where possible)

Unit Capacity (temporary set),

Bar top physical barriers / screen

Social Distancing Markers

House Rules for Punters (signage)

Sanitizer in place,

Hourly Toilet cleaning regime,

One Way Systems where possible,

Enhanced, increased surface cleaning,

Additional 1m mitigation

In addition 1m requires :

- No standing – all customers seated
- Face coverings by staff
- Clear systems for safe ordering and payments
- Clear systems for safe use of toilet facilities
- Use of screens between seating areas
- Good ventilation
- Good signage
- Reduced noise measures e.g. no background music, to reduce need for customers to shout
- Clear messaging on need to provide contact details to support Test & Protect

Public Rules (examples)

Advise patrons displaying current symptoms, or self-isolating /self-quarantine to stay at home. (Social Media)

Capacity (temporary displayed),

Please Sanitize or wash hands on entry (wash your hands thoroughly Regularly)

Great to see you back, please work with our team to keep you and others safe and ensure compliance with current guidelines;

- Only visit if you are feeling well
- Sanitize or wash hands on entry (wash your hands thoroughly Regularly)
- We are operating table service only, wait to be seated.
- Please provide contact details to staff prior to service, to support Test & Protect,
- All patrons must be seated, please avoid unnecessary circulation.
- Please don't move furniture it is placed for maximum Social Distancing,
- We are operating a 1m plus policy
- Avoid shaking hands & close contact, where possible remain 2m apart,
- Avoid unnecessary contact with solid surfaces
- Where appropriate please use suitable face coverings
- Respect others and be kind
